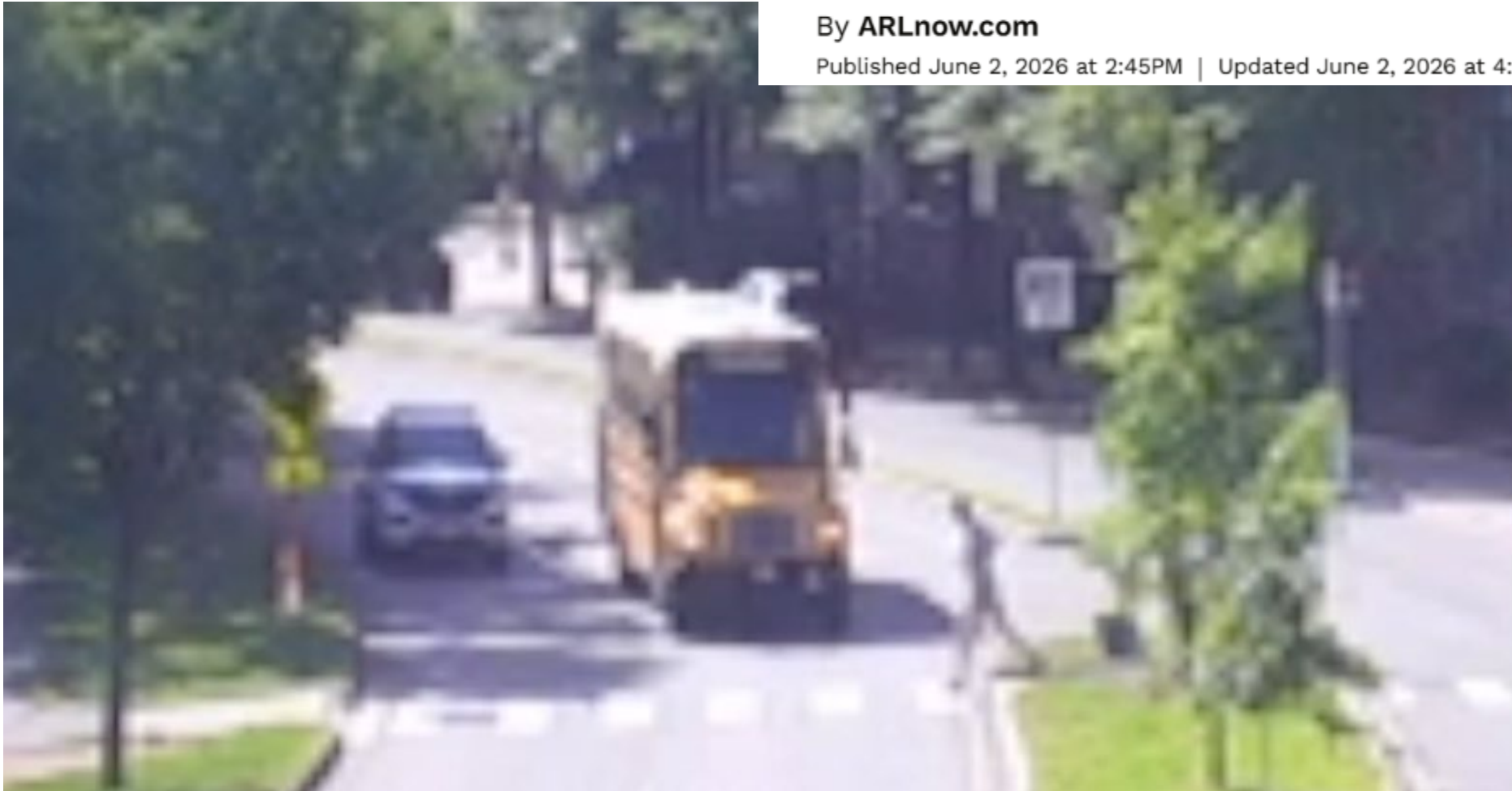

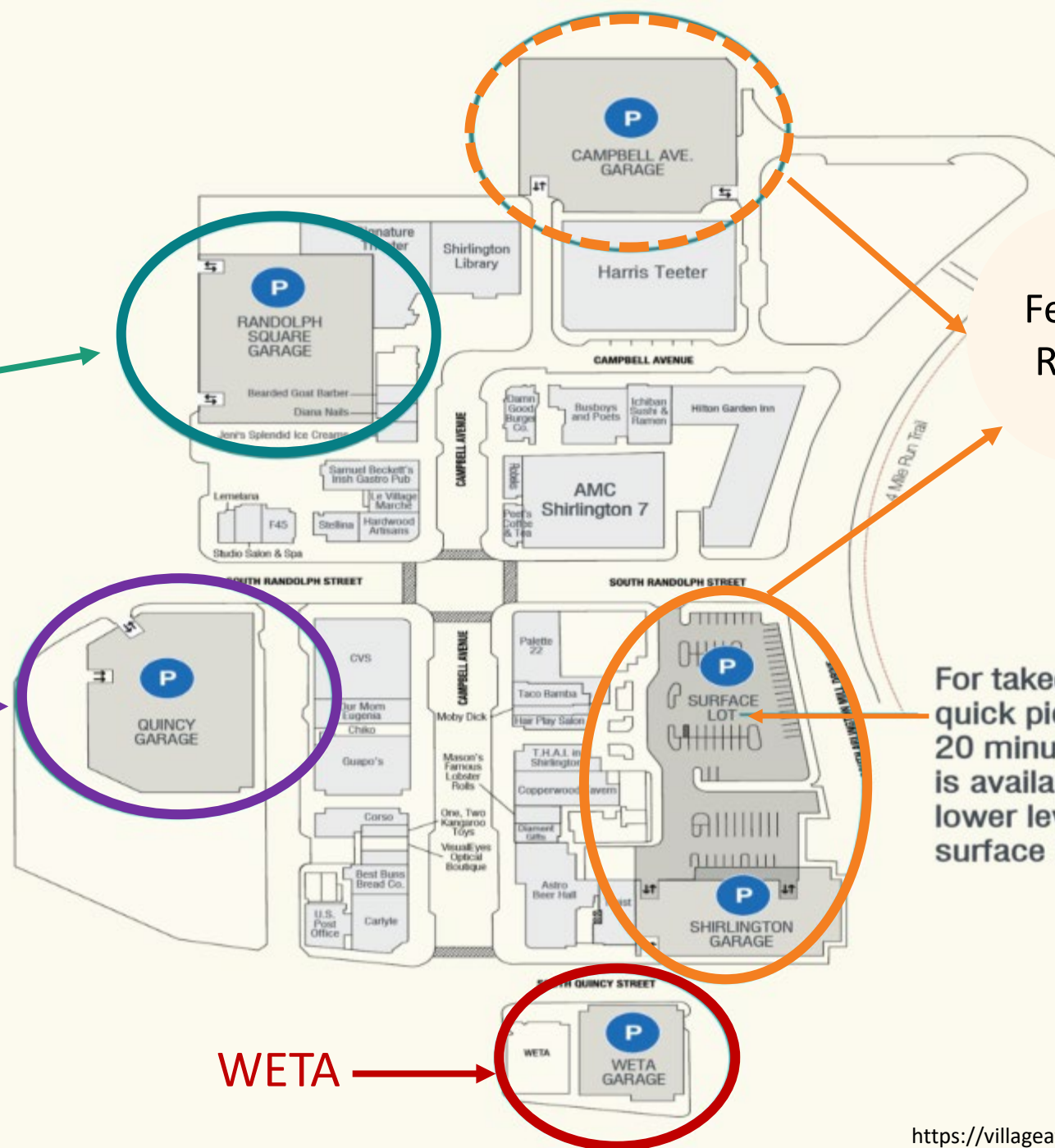

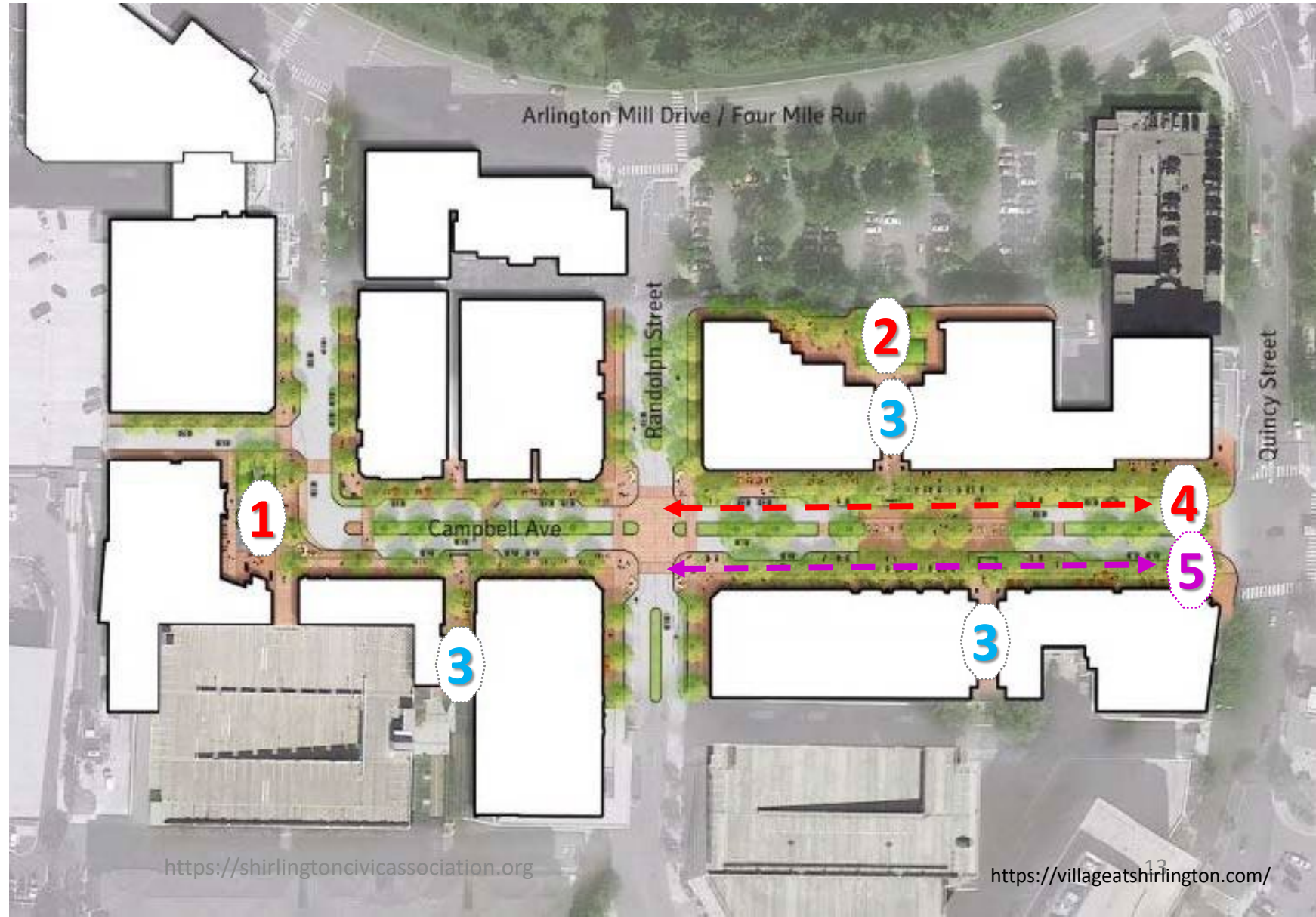

Village Update: Construction

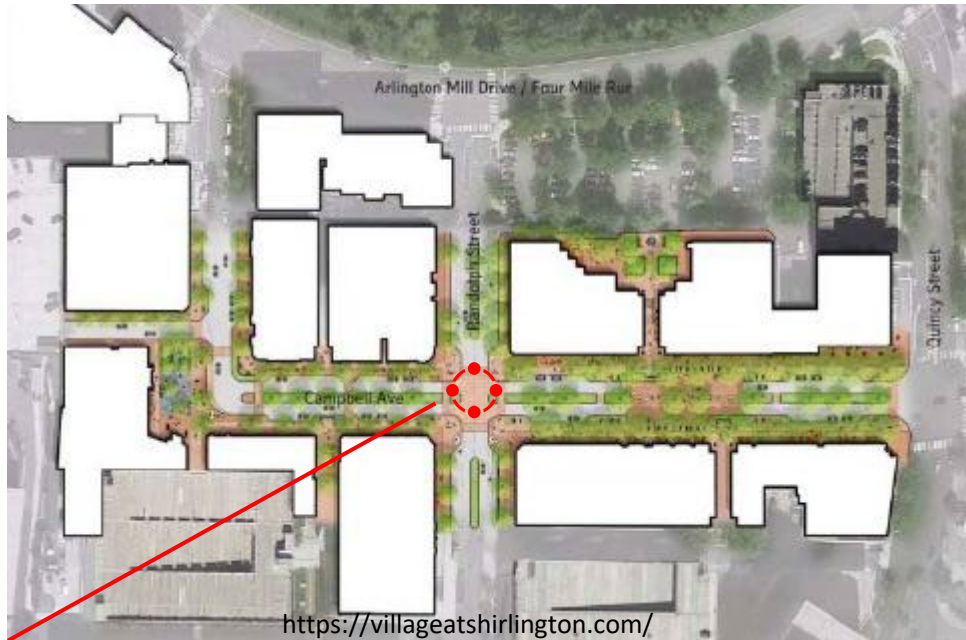
Construction started early 2026

1. Library Plaza – **under way**
2. North Court – **under way**
3. Vias – **nearly complete**
4. East Side Campbell Ave – **under way**
5. West Side Campbell Ave – **will begin after East Side is complete and reopened**

November 2026



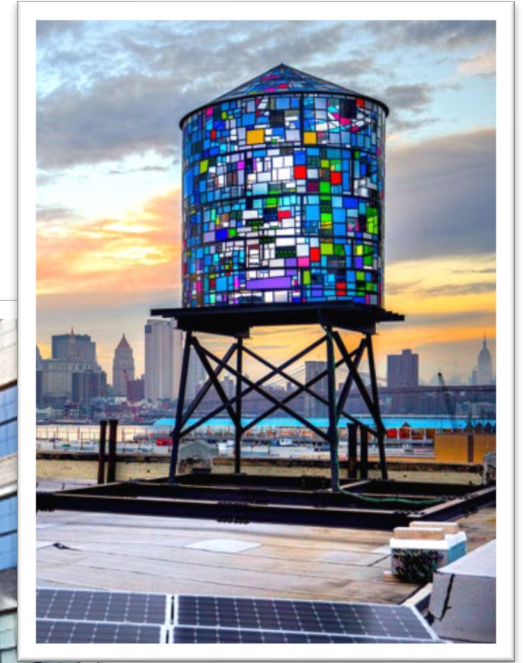
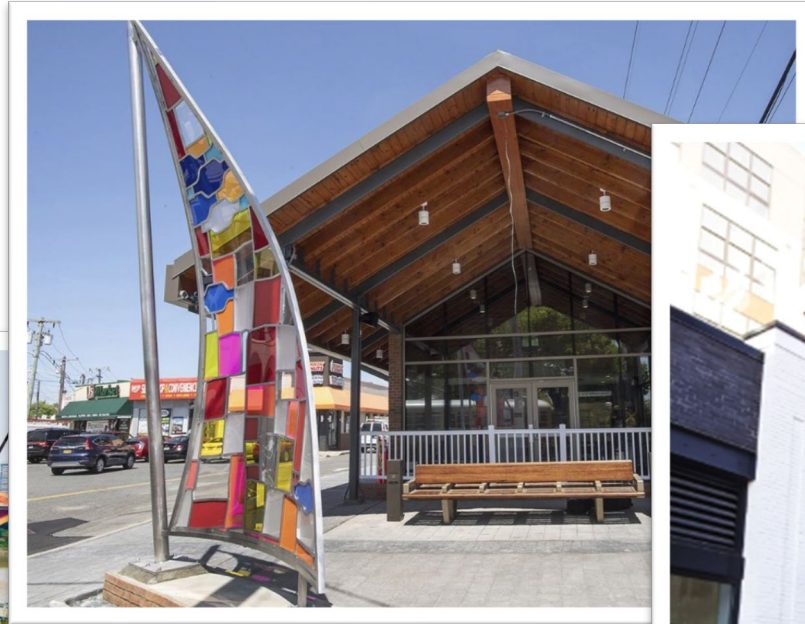
Village Update: Public Art
